“All children have the best start in life to create a better future for them and for the nation.”

Working in collaboration with children and in partnership with families, educators use the Outcomes to guide their planning for children’s wellbeing and learning.

The Framework conveys high expectations for all children’s play and leisure activities in school age care settings. It communicates these expectations through the following five Outcomes:

Outcome 1: Children have a strong sense of identity- showing interest in other children and being part of a group

Outcome 2: Children are connected with and contribute to their world – take action to assist other children and to participate in social groups

Outcome 3: Children have a strong sense of wellbeing – children show self-regulation and manage their emotions in ways that reflect the feelings and needs of others

Outcome 4: Children are confident and involved learners – initiate and contribute to play and leisure experiences emerging from their own ideas

Outcome 5: Children are effective communicators

- **Recess, Lunch & Afternoon Snacks**
- I agree to delegate my authority to supervising Children Services Educators. Such supervisors may take whatever disciplinary action they deem necessary to ensure the safety, well-being, and successful conduct of the students as a group and individually. I understand that such a programme will follow the OSHC Student Behaviour Management Policy.
- In the event of an accident or illness and contact with me being impracticable or impossible, I authorise the Children Services Educators to arrange whatever medical or surgical treatment a registered medical practitioner considers necessary. I will pay all medical and dental expenses incurred on behalf of my child.
