Student ICT Agreement

Expectations around the appropriate use of computers

Respect for the equipment

- care will be taken when using any ICT device
 - keep food and drink away
 - ensure it is returned and put away properly for recharging
 - report any accidental damage
 - treat all devices with care

Respect for other learners

- only access the devices through your own account and password
- only access your own files
 - leave other people's files and passwords alone – do not delete their files or change passwords
- leave other people's computers alone – don't turn them off when people are using them – let them get on with their learning
- always ensure that what is written or posted is polite and respectful
- let an adult know if you receive rude or bullying messages. Don't forward or share them with others.

Respect for yourself and your own learning

- stay on the learning task – the sites that the teacher has asked you to be on
- only search appropriate sites – sites that are relevant to the learning task
 - don't deliberately search for something that is rude or violent
- protect passwords and don't share them with anyone except trusted adults
- only ever join spaces with parents or teacher's guidance and permission
- never answer questions online that ask for personal information

If the agreement is broken...

- reminder about what is appropriate
- no access to the computer until the end of the next school day
- no access to the computer for five school days
- no access to the computer for the remainder of the term

Teachers will record this information on the teams link located on Sentral front page

This will be reset at the start of each term

Teachers will be able to block and unblock student access for lessons needed for learning. Eg a child can access word but not the internet.
