In addition to our literacy work, we've also begun our journey with the **Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL)** team. This important initiative supports us in creating safe, positive and supportive learning environments. Our first step is to reflect on our current school values to ensure they are meaningful, relevant, and truly represent the students and community we serve today. We'll be seeking input from students, staff, and families throughout this process.

Following a rigorous application and interview process, I'm very pleased to announce that **Ellen Barr** has been appointed **Deputy Principal** (Term 1 to Term 3, 2026). Ellen has worked as a Literacy Coach at St Leonards and Alberton Primary School. Currently, she is the Senior Leader (Curriculum) at Christies Downs. Ellen possesses the high quality skills required to help lead us through our improvement journey with LGU and PBL. She will also continue to drive our implementation of the SA Curriculum. Importantly, Ellen will work alongside teachers and SSOs to ensure consistent language and pedagogical practices across the school.



Sonia's upcoming long service leave will be a huge loss for our school community. Her presence, passion, and dedication will be deeply missed. We'll make sure to properly celebrate and acknowledge her incredible contributions towards the end of the year.




